

How to Stop Calls From Scammers



- 1 Hang Up.**
When you get a robocall, don't press any numbers to get on a "Do not call" list. This often leads to more robocalls.
- 2 Block or Label the Caller.**
Consider blocking or labeling the caller. See what your phone carrier offers to help you block scam calls. There are even apps to help if you have a smartphone.
- 3 Don't trust Caller ID.**
Scam calls can show up as any name and number, even government agencies.
